



Jack Hort Memorial Community Pool Lesson Policy

DECEMBER 2019

Fees: The level of Aquatic Education fees is determined by Healesville High School and the Manager of JHMCP. Aquatic Education is GST free.

Payment of Fees: Fees are due in full at the commencement of each term. Instalment payments may be arranged in consultation with Manager and full payment must be completed before the end of the term.

If the payment schedule is not completed, then we reserve the right to not re-enrol the participant until the account is settled. This may result in the loss of preferred day and time choice.

An adjustment to fees may be negotiated for children who are in a joint custody arrangement and may only be attending lessons fortnightly.

Failure to attend two or more consecutive lessons without contacting JHMCP, may result in the participant being removed from lessons.

Fee Structure: Total cost per term is dependent on length of term. If you have more than one child in lessons, 2nd and subsequent children receive a one lesson discount for that term.

Swim for Free Card: A swim for free card is issued to the participant if payment for lessons is paid in full at the commencement of the term. This card enables the user to swim free of charge anytime during the term attending lessons.

Casual Lesson Fees: Available for families visiting or holidaying in the Yarra Valley.

Illness: If the participant is unable to attend their scheduled lesson, a credit will be applied upon presentation of a medical certificate.

Days and Times: We will endeavour to place children into lessons at times and days requested. Where more than one family member is enrolled we will endeavour to allocate lessons appropriately.

We conduct pre aquatic lessons Monday to Saturday mornings and lessons for school children Monday to Thursday afternoons and Saturday morning.

We use the Royal Life Saving Society Swim and Survive program of which we are a licensee.

Our aim is to limit lessons, wherever possible to a maximum of 5 participants.

Our teaching staff are Austswim qualified.

Goal: To make Aquatic Education available for everyone in our community.
